 (Board members gave this the highest rating of 4.)
- Behaviour Management Policy It was felt there was a need to bring the message back to the parents.
 (Board members gave this a rating of 2.)
- AIEOs We don't have an Aboriginal Community.
 (Board members gave this a rating of 1.)
- Training and skill development opportunities to parents and teachers.
 (Board members gave this a rating of 3)

It was agreed that when we next look into the details of these domains, we should focus on the domains with low ratings for planning and development in the Community and Engagement Plan.

	Unambiguously embraces and celebrates the diversity of families; Authentic opportunities for staff to lead, grow and impact change in progressing both the school's strategic direction and that of the network; Decisions about the allocation of financial, physical and human resources are researched and evidence-based, with a focus on improving outcomes for students; A culture of collective efficacy and commitment by all to be accountable and responsible for every student's journey; and Progress is everyone's business, attention is given to creating a shared culture in he assessment, monitoring and reviewing of student performance. The next Public School Review will be in 3 years time as it is deemed to be the most appropriate with the changes that the school will be undergoing in the next few years. Karina thanked the School Board for its support throughout the process. The School Board thanked the Principal and the teachers for a job very well done. The school board acknowledged and congratulated the Principal for her leadership and management of the school self assessment and review process with a large staff, to a high level across all domains, particularly in light of her limited time in the role in a solo capacity.
